Hello Julia: Since we started discussions last November, which were then followed by my last communication in December, and after a lengthy and costly legal dispute the METALAST trademark ownership issue was settled just a few weeks ago. As you may or may not be aware Dean and Madylon Meiling, the current owners of Metalast Surface Technology, LLC (MST) are now required under federal court order to cease the use of the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) METALAST trademark, name and brand "*in any fashion or manner whatsoever*" effective June 9th, 2015 (Sur/Fin 2015). The lingering threat of pending litigation is NOW OVER and the parties are free to pursue their own individual objectives.

As the founders and current majority owners of METALAST International, Inc. (MII) the Semas family retains control of all rights to the USPTO METALAST Trademark. There exists today a fortuitous opportunity for Chemetall to gain control of the METALAST brand, with its considerable number of manufacturer specifications, approvals and certifications. This time sensitive proposal insures Chemetall Americas continuity of business and provides an even greater ability for Chemetall Group to open new markets in chromate conversion coatings, corrosion control, galvanizing and in the anodizing sectors.

To be clear, there are three (3) other NAVAIR licensee's that have access to the Navy TCP formulations, and unlike MST one of whom has international rights. Additionally, all MST's existing line of anodizing chemicals are presently private label manufactured and owned by SIC Technologies under the name of "METALAST....." These products consist of one hundred (100) different type of cleaners, deoxidizers, etchants, seals, additives and dyes. Similarly, the METALAST AA-200 additive is a commercially available chemical and its legal ownership is held by an independent chemical company, not MST. In the very near future only MII will have the exclusive rights to purchase, relabel and sell the product as METALAST AA-200 for distribution worldwide.

As a point of reference other than the newly developed and patented OCP 6800 (zero chrome) chemical, which is soon to be owned by MST all other one hundred and nineteen (119) MST chemical products are either owned by and/or patented by third parties, thus our company is entirely free to negotiate with, license, partner and/or form alliances with any of other chemical company. Therefore, as of June 9th, 2015 MII will have the legal and exclusive ownership to the METALAST USPTO registered trademark, name and brand in the global market place free from any type of limitation or restriction.

Greg and I were initially lead to believe that there might be a chance for Chemetall and the Semas family to work together, especially considering our previous 8-year relationship. We will not interfere with ongoing discussions you may be having, nor do we want to in anyway unduly influence your intention to align with the Meilings and their MST company. If for whatever reason you wish not to confidentially pursue further discussions about working together we will honor your decision. If this is the case we intend to explore other opportunities and will conduct more formal discussions with one of the other Navy TCP licensee's. The result of this timely alliance will be to continue to offer the trusted METALAST brand internationally in all available market segments directly competing with Chemetall in North America.

If I do not hear back from you within the next 48-hours we will just assume you have chosen a different path and will be working with MST and likewise we will immediately pursue our other available options.
